COURSE INFORMATION

They are nationally recognised qualifications within the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

COURSE DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT METHODS

CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability)

The course is delivered over 20 hours per week (14 hours face to face and 6 hours online learning) over 30 college weeks. Students are on campus for the classroom delivery and practical application of learning in the simulation lab.

In addition to this, students undertake their practical placement off campus over 40 hours per week over 3 college weeks in your last term.

Assessment methodology for these qualifications, may include but is not limited to tests and examinations, classroom and simulation participation, case studies, placement assessment, essays, role plays, group assessments and presentations.

Students are expected to bring a notebook / laptop to class.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

International applicants must be 18 years or older and have:

Year 11 or equivalent certificate of senior secondary education.

Recommended English Level: IELTS 5.5 (with no individual band less than 5.0) or equivalent.(If the level of English is insufficient, a suitable course can be organised).

- Students must undertake their practical placement off campus over 40 hours per week over 3 college weeks in the last term.
