The CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability) will provide you with the knowledge and skills required to follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. A great program to start your career in aged care!

COURSE INFORMATION

Our Individual Support course has been developed according to the requirements of the Community Services Training Package (CHC) and has been approved for delivery by the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA). They are nationally recognised qualifications within the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

COURSE DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT METHODS

CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability)

The course is delivered over 20 hours per week (14 hours face to face and 6 hours online learning) over 30 college weeks. Students are on campus for the classroom delivery and practical application of learning in the clinical simulation lab.

In addition to this, students undertake their practical placement off campus over 40 hours per week over 3 college weeks in your last term.

Assessment methodology for these qualifications, may include but is not limited to tests and examinations, classroom and simulation participation, case studies, clinical placement assessment, essays, role plays, group assessments and presentations.

Students are expected to bring a notebook / laptop to class.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

International applicants must be 18 years or older and have:

Year 11 or equivalent certificate of senior secondary education.

Recommended English Level: IELTS 6.0 (with no individual band less than 5.0) or equivalent. (If the level of English is insufficient, a suitable course can be organised).

Practical Placement:

- Students must undertake their practical placement off campus over 40 hours per week over 3 college weeks in the last term.
- Skills Training Australia has an extensive list of industry partners and will organise the practical placements for all students within Metropolitan Melbourne. A current and satisfactory Police Record Check, Working with Children Check and NDIS number are mandatory and a copy must be provided to Skills Training Australia prior to commencing placement. If students do not have these documents, we will assist students to apply for this during the first term of the course. It is also mandatory to have an annual Influenza and Covid-19 vaccination prior to placement in an Aged Care setting. Students will be required to provide evidence of this.
